

## **Juan de Fuca District Report**

**18 November 2007**

- Juan de Fuca Squadron is financially stable with 62 regular, 14 family, 1 associate and 1 lady associate members.
- Boating course progressing well with 12 students (our classroom limits us to a maximum of 14 students).
- Boating Course exam scheduled for Dec 4 & PCOC on Dec 11 along with a Squadron social.
- Fees for spring course due on Dec 1<sup>st</sup> – anticipate a full class of 14.
