

DTO Report  
to District Meeting  
January 27, 2008

All Squadrons except Pender Island are running a Winter/Spring Boating course. Numbers are down by 88 from last years total but Saltspring was just registering as I was preparing this report and other Squadron numbers are still somewhat in flux.

Other courses currently running: Pender has 4 Piloting students, Saanich Pen has 9 Piloting students, Victoria has 11 Fund of Wx students and they are expected to continue on with Global at the completion of Fundamentals.

Maritime Radio and additional courses are planned in several Squadrons but not registered yet.

The CN course planned for January was cancelled due to lack of registration. John and Steph as well as Len and Richard did lots of prep work for this course and all deserve our thanks.

Victoria Squadron Piloting students have completed the course with a 96.5% class average. Quite a standard to follow. Congratulations to the students and to Janet Fraser, their instructor.

None of the Squadrons have submitted the DTO copy of the CPS2 a&b forms to me yet from the classes that were completed in December so I have no results from these Boating classes. This was a point of discussion at the STO meeting this morning.

At this mornings STO meeting, the PCOC protocol that was distributed by John Gullick was discussed. All STOs should have received a copy from HQ and must be aware of the contents. Commanders please take note.

Web based CPS2s are still not on the web but we're told that access is coming. When the forms are on the web, reporting should be more timely.

I plan to attend the National training meetings in Toronto at the end of March and agenda items for discussion will be distributed to the STOs as they become available, for feedback at the next District training meeting March 16<sup>th</sup> , prior to the National meetings.
